Free parking in the village in December

The District Council are providing free parking on Saturday, 8th December 2015 to help promote Small Business Saturday which is a national campaign to promote local high streets and independent shops. In addition, there will be free parking at Sea Road the day before on Friday 7th December as part of the village Christmas Shopping Evening and Carol Service.

Sea Road Toilets

The Parish Council has been notified by the District Council that the refurbishment



work to the Sea Road toilet block has been delayed for up to a year while a bat survey is conducted as part of the planning process for the site.

White Horse Pub site

The Parish Council has been notified that the current owners of the White Horse pub in Keyhaven Road are aiming to sell the site. The pub is registered as an Asset of Community Value and as such, if any Community Interest Group would like to make a bid for this asset they have until 17th December to do so. Anyone interested in being involved should contact the parish Office as soon as possible.

Memorial Benches available

The Parish Council has identified a number of pre-sponsored Memorial Benches at various locations around the village which are now available to new sponsors. Prices include a 20 year insurance and



maintenance contract which would involve a full refurbishment of the bench along with a new plaque to sit alongside the original plaque. In addition, there are a number of new benches available at the children's seafront playpark for sponsorship. For more details contact the parish office.

Bag it and Bin it! Dog bags available from Parish Office to help tackle Milford's Mess

We are sad to report that dog fouling continues to be blight our lovely village. The Parish Council has recently purchased additional signage to go in the Pleasure Grounds and other points around the village. This anti-social behaviour causes disease and is generally horrid. We know that the majority of dog owners are responsible and as usual it is the few who spoil it for everybody. Dog bags are available to purchase from the Parish Office at the very reasonable rate of £1 per roll of 50.



Once used, **the bags can now be placed in ANY PUBLIC BIN in the village (not just the red dog waste bins).** Bag it and bin it and keep Milford-on-Sea special!

How to report a pothole or fallen tree



It's the time of year when potholes seem to appear overnight and trees can be blown down in the windy winter weather. There is a quick and easy way of reporting these

issues to the County Council – just visit their website: www.hants.gov.uk and click on the "Report a road problem". You can then select from a variety of issues including potholes, flooding or fallen trees. Enter in a few quick details and the County Council will investigate and act accordingly.

Grants available for groups

The Parish Council has a small community support budget to provide small one-off grants to help support community organisations. The priority is to assist groups who have only a limited fundraising capacity of maybe starting a new community activity. There is still some funding available for this financial year but requests have to be made by March 2019. If you would like to apply, please contact the Parish Office.
